**I. Presentations:**

1. Proposed Summer Service Changes

Principal Planner-Short Range Roberto Gonzalez provided information regarding the 2011 Summer Service Changes. (see attachment)

Chair Martinez - None of this service is going away?

Gonzalez - That is correct.

Chair Martinez - I have been approached several times regarding Decker Ln., why can't we extend that route? Have we looked at that?

Gonzalez - Yes we have looked at it and we have asked if the county would work with us on that issue.

Chair Martinez - Could we get closer to the area?

Gonzalez - There is no way to turn our vehicles around.

Chair Martinez - Make sure we are still considering it because I am still getting phones calls regarding this.

Gonzalez - CARTS is another option but their fare is significantly higher.

Public Comment:

1. Zena Mitchell stated she does not support changes on the 137 route. This is the only bus that services this route. This will add 15 minutes to her route. If consolidated it would be 7 routes, not consolidated its 9 routes. The bus 137 route goes through Mueller go through the development. The 37 does not go through the development, now it goes outside the development.

2. L. F. Wilkes commented this is a small change from a vast wonderful bus system. The change from January at Stassney, the times changes are inconvenient, look at changes and reinstate the bus that arrives at 2:18 p.m. bus that travels north. I spoke with Ms. Wilkes regarding this issue prior to the meeting. We are not leaving on time at the southern point. In addition to that there is an Alternative school in the area is adding to the problem as well and that makes the bus not arrive on-time. We have asked our scheduling staff to do is look at the on-time performance, the riding data, when we have cases like this we usually insert an extra short haul bus and address that portion of the route that is overloaded.
