I. Discussion items

1. Proposed Service changes
Proposed January 2012 service changes were provided by James Gamez, Principal Planner and Roberto Gonzalez, Principal Planner Manager from the Planning department. (see attachment)

Public Comment:

1. Lee Hill wanted to thank staff for explaining the changes to Route 100. They did not talk about on-time performance when making the changes.

Chris Riley asked if the changes to Riverside and Ben White will affect on-time performance.

James Gamez - It will definitely impact on-time performance, with the construction, also there is some schedule flexibility with adding an additional bus to this route.

Riley - Do we know when construction will begin?

Gamez - We don't have the exact dates.

Roberto Gonzalez stated that regarding Route 100, some of these changes are not staff recommendations but a part of a task force of stakeholders' recommendations.

Riley - How many stops will there be downtown with the changes to Riverside?

Gonzalez - About three stops.

Riley - Concerned regarding the impact?

Gonzalez - We will work closely with staff to minimize issues regarding construction.

Riley - Do you have any idea what the duration on that project will be?

Gonzalez - No, sometimes we will hear duration of a project but sometimes it could be extended longer than expected.

Riley - Thanked Gonzalez for the outreach done and asked him to summarize the feedback received from outreach.

Gonzalez - We received very good feedback, it was a really productive meeting, it went well. There were representatives from the hotels etc... at the meeting. Stop placement was there biggest concern, they just wanted information on where there customers could get service from their establishments, good consensus from outreach.
