Program Guide Addendum

The RideShare Program, as referred to in this document, means the Capital Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Capital Metro) RideShare program. The driver, as referred to in this document, means the person, approved by Capital Metro, who operates the Carpool vehicle as a volunteer primary driver.

This addendum establishes additional policies for the RideShare program. All members (riders and drivers) are bound by these policy additions.

1. The vehicle issued will be a Toyota Prius automobile.
2. The minimum membership requirement is four members (including the primary driver).
3. Each member is required to ride three days per week.
4. Mileage is reported to Capital Metro on a monthly basis.
5. Eating in the *GREENride* vehicle will not be allowed.
6. Only beverages in closed containers will be allowed in the vehicle.
7. All volunteer drivers must sign an Agreement Addendum for the replacement cost for the Master Key.
8. Drivers must read the Pocket Reference Guide
 - ✓ Don't watch the computer screen while driving
 - ✓ Take care of the orange cables in the engine compartment
 - ✓ Keep the battery vent (right rear passenger seat) open
 - ✓ Loaner cars are not available
