## Manor & CapMetro Election

During a special election on November 8, the City of Manor will allow voters to vote on Proposition A, which questions whether Manor should continue participation in CapMetro.

---

## Project Connect & Manor

In an effort to expand the Rail through Project Connect, there is a plan to build the Green Line running from Downtown Austin to Colony Park, with future extensions to Manor and Elgin. The City of Manor's participation in Project Connect could be impacted by the outcome of this vote.

---

### What if a majority of Manor residents choose "NO"?

- The day after the election results are canvassed, CapMetro would no longer offer transit services in Manor. This includes Express and on-demand Pickup services.

- **In accordance with Texas law,** Manor residents would continue to pay the existing 1-cent sales tax for about 4.4 years, until the city's existing obligation is fully paid. This is currently estimated to be \$9.8 million as of March 2022.

### What if a majority of Manor residents choose "YES"?

- CapMetro services would continue, including Express and on-demand Pickup services. Services would continue to be funded by a 1-cent sales tax in the City of Manor.
- CapMetro's Build Central Texas program and capital funds would provide up to \$2,650,238 in funding to the City of Manor if the cost of service is less than the 1-cent sales tax revenue. These funds would go toward transit-supportive capital projects.
