Notable Incidents and Events

- The Community Intervention Specialist (CIS) team had a notable success story with an elderly gentleman staying at Republic Square.
- October 6-9 PSEM participated in the Austin Transit Partnership (ATP), Austin Light Rail Threat and Vulnerability Assessment (TVA).
- At the close of the FY2025 budget, the physical security team spent 87% of their capital budget, which was well above the agency average.

In the Community

- The Public Safety Ambassador team responded to 350 calls for service in October.
- The Emergency Management team attended the City of Austin, Austin Climate Action and Resilience Workshop focused on Cooling and Warming Centers.

Emergency Management Update


- The Emergency Management team continued assisting the Rail Department to recover funds used for reconstruction of infrastructure related to the July floods. The final submission to FEMA for reimbursement is nearly completed.
- Planning for the Battery Electric Bus emergency exercise series is underway.

Security Technology Projects Overview

- The Security Technology team completed camera replacements (end of life cycle) at all CapMetro Park & Rides.
- Currently the team is upgrading all access control hardware at CapMetro facilities.

NTD Safety & Security Events

A security event that results in an injury requiring transport away from the scene, or a fatality are classified as major events requiring a report to the National Transit Database (NTD), which is administered by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

There are other NTD reportable safety & security events security (S&S), such as evacuations for life safety reasons, or a collision between vehicles which requires towing.

Executive Summary & Overview



Metric	September	October	November	Trend
Reports/Events	40	49	39	Volatile: Noticeable rise in Oct followed by a comparable decline in Nov.
Arrests	11	14	11	Cyclical: Activity returned to previous frequency after a brief October spike.
Citations	6	8	2	Significant downward shift: November showed the lowest citation activity of the period.
CAD Events*	499	467	518	Strong rebound in November after an October dip.

Across the three-month period, activity levels showed noticeable fluctuation, rather than a steady rise or decline. October acted as a peak month for several metrics, followed by a broad decrease in November, except for CAD Events, which surged to their highest point.

*CAD event numbers presented in this report are limited by the RMS and may not capture all activity

Location Analysis - Area of Focus



Location	September	October	November
Bus Stops	27	37	15

CapMetro Property	18	12	17

- **Bus Stops:** Activity rose sharply in October but dropped significantly in November, ending well below September levels.
- **On Buses:** Activity increased in October and then returned to the same level as September in November, showing a temporary mid-period spike.
- **CapMetro Property:** Activity dipped in October but climbed again in November, nearly returning to September levels.


Overall: October saw the highest activity across most locations, followed by a broad decline in November, with the exception of CapMetro Property, which rebounded after an October dip.
