

### Meals on Wheels Central Texas Client Assistance Program



- Provide case management and financial assistance (including rent, utilities, mortgage, financial education, and other housing expenses) to Meals on Wheels Central Texas (MOWCTX) clients who are most at-risk of displacement.
- Case managers will also provide prevent housing displacement and maintain housing stability. budgeting/financial education, as well as community referrals and resources to supplement our services.



#### **Communities in School of Central Texas**

CIS Student and Family Assistance: Relational, Timely Support to Prevent Housing Displacement

- Student and Family Assistance (SAFA) program provides financial support to address housing insecurity, helping to stabilize students' home lives and preventing displacement.
  - Integrate Project Connect rental assistance into existing financial support processes and provide training to campus-based staff
  - Connect students/families to financial wellness
    resources and events

Rental Assistance for Families of Color in Austin's Eastern Crescent



#### **PROGRAM DETAILS**

Anti-displacement rental assistance for MSVW clients (or any member of Austin's Maternal Health Equity Collaborative (MHEC)) over 3 years



#### **PROGRAM DETAILS**

Increase tenant stabilization along the Project Connect corridor and maintain the important services and history that ATC has provided the Austin community by:

- Conducting General Outreach and Education on Tenants Rights along the Project Connect Corridor
- Developing and Updating Community Education Materials
- Forming and Supporting Tenants Associations along the Project Connect Corridor
- Bolstering Fair Housing Assistance Services





### Workers Defense Project Building And Strengthening Tenant Action

Combatting Displacement Through Tenant and Worker Power

- Educate community members on land use and affordable housing policies
- Community Organizing -

Grow and scale the capacity of a cohort of nonprofits to increase community land trust availability, establishing long-term affordable homeownership opportunities along Project Connect transit lines to help households stabilize their finances and avoid displacement.

- The Asociación de Residentes North Lamar (ARNL) is a Manufactured Housing Community owned by residents as a cooperative.
- The program will assist the residents in developing a property tax abatement strategy.






**Goodwill Industries of Central Texas** Connections to Work

#### **PROGRAM DETAILS**

Support economic mobility within impacted areas through workforce programs providing job training and occupational skills training credentials for living-wage positions; financial capability services; and direct rent/mortgage and utility relief for participants.





**Life Anew Restorative Justice Inc.** Life Anew Anti-Displacement Property Ownership

- Education for eligible homeowners on:
  - Land ownership
  - Estate planning
  - Zero Energy
  - Condo Regimes
- Financial Literacy including credit repair, equity access, and access to banks/lenders
